



Parent Code of Conduct

I will not force my child to participate in sports.

I will remember that children participate to have fun and that the game is for youth, not adults.

I will inform the coach of any disability or ailment that may affect the safety of my child or others.

I will learn the rules of the game and the policies of the league.

I will be a positive role model and encourage sportsmanship by showing respect and courtesy, and by demonstrating positive support for all players, coaches, officials and spectators.

I will not engage in any kind of unsportsmanlike conduct with any official, coach, player, or parent such as booing and taunting; refusing to shake hands; or using profane language or gestures.

I will teach my child to play by the rules and resolve conflicts without hostility or violence.

I will ask that my child treat other players, coaches, officials and spectators with respect regardless of race, creed, color, sex or ability.

I will teach my child that doing one's best is more important than winning, so that my child will never feel defeated by the outcome of a game or his/her performance.

I will praise my child for competing fairly and trying hard.

I will never ridicule or yell at my child or other participants for making a mistake or losing a game.

I will emphasize skill development and practices and how they benefit my child over winning. I will also de-emphasize competition in the lower age groups.

I will promote the emotional and physical wellbeing of players ahead of any personal desire for my child to win.

I will respect the officials and their authority during games, will not question, discuss, or confront coaches at the game, and will take time to speak with coaches at an agreed upon time and place.

I will demand a sports environment for my child that is free from drugs, tobacco, and alcohol and I will refrain from their use while at the baseball field.

I will refrain from coaching my child or other players during games and practices, unless I am one.

I will correct my child's actions if they adversely affect others, and will remove him from the baseball field if he or she refuses to cooperate.

I will attempt to attend as many practices and games as possible and acknowledge the ultimate responsibility for my child's actions at all practices and games lies with my child and me; coaches will coach; umpires will umpire; I will parent.
